

**Materials:**

Cotton yarn

(ex: *Bernat Handicrafter*, *Bernat Cot-n-Corn*, *Lily Sugar-n-Cream*)

US Size 8 needles

This pattern uses the “wrap & turn” method on short rows. To “wrap & turn” knit the number of stitches indicated in the pattern, then slip next stitch, bring yarn to back and return slipped stitch back to left needle. Turn work. It can be knit without the “wrap”, which will only slightly change the finished look.



Cast on 15 stitches

- Row 1: Slip first stitch as if to purl, knit to end.
- Row 2: K3, YO, K to last st, **DO NOT KNIT LAST ST**, wrap & turn.
- Row 3: Knit
- Row 4: K3, YO, K to last 2 sts, wrap & turn.
- Row 5: Knit
- Row 6: K3, YO, k to last 3 sts, wrap & turn.
- Row 7: Knit
- Row 8: Bind off 3 sts, K2, YO, K to last 4 sts, wrap & turn.
- Row 9: Knit
- Row 10: K3, YO, K to last 5 sts, wrap & turn.
- Row 11: Knit
- Row 12: K3, YO, K to last 6 sts, wrap & turn.
- Row 13: Knit
- Row 14: Bind off 3 sts, K2, YO, K to last 7 sts, wrap & turn.
- Row 15: Knit
- Row 16: K3, YO, K to last 8 sts, wrap & turn.
- Row 17: Knit
- Row 18: K3, YO, K to last 9 sts, wrap & turn.
- Row 19: Knit
- Row 20: Bind off 3 sts, knit across (15 sts total).

Repeat rows 1-20 seven more times -- 8 spirals in totals.

Bind off, leaving a tail long enough to sew a seam.

Sew the cast-on edge to the bound-off edge.
