BEANIES for BABIES Charity Knitting Project

Materials:

- 1 skein Bernat Softee Baby
- US Size 6 (4 mm) 16" Circular and/or double-point needles (dpn's)

Gauge: 20 sts and 24 rows = 4"

THE KNITTING DOODLE Children's HOSPITAL ELITHONISTICAL ELITHONIST

Directions:

Cast on 66 stitches; place marker and join.

Brim:

Round 1: *K1, p1. Repeat from * to end of round. Repeat Round 1 five (5) more times.

Body:

All Rounds: Knit.

Repeat until piece measures 4¾" from the beginning.

**On last row, place a marker every 11 stitches.

Crown Decreases: (if using a small circular needle divide the work onto 3 dpn's when they no longer span the circular comfortably)

Round 1: *K to 2 sts before marker, K2tog*. Repeat from * to* to end of round Repeat this round until 6 sts remain.

Cut yarn, leaving a tail. Draw tail through remaining stitches on the needle. Pull gently to close the hole. Secure and weave in ends.

Please ensure that you are knitting in a smoke-free environment.
