

**Materials:**

Sport weight (#3) yarn

US Size 6 needles

Black embroidery thread

Small pompoms

**Gauge:** not critical

Cast on 24 stitches.

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Knit

Row 3: K5, M1, K5, M1, K4, M1, K5, M1, K5

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: Knit

Row 6: Purl

Repeat rows 5 &amp; 6 until piece measures 2-1/2" from cast-on edge.

(approx. 14 rows)

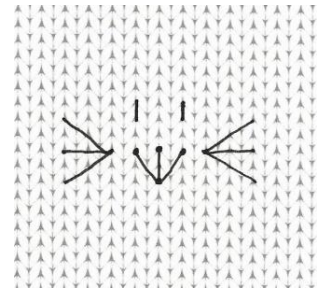
Crown Decreases:

Row 1: (K2tog), repeat to end of row. (14 sts)

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: (k2tog), repeat to end of row. (7 sts)

Break yarn and thread through remaining stitches. BEFORE sewing down the back seam embroider a face for your bunny. Sew down back seam and weave in ends.



EARS (make 2)

Cast on 5 stitches.

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Kfb in each stitch (10 sts)

Row 3-6: Knit

Row 7: K2tog, K6, K2tog

Row 8: Knit

Row 9: K2tog, K4, K2tog

Row 9: K2tog, K4, K2tog

Row 10: Knit

Row 11: K2tog, K2, K2tog

Row 12: Knit

Row 13: K2tog twice

Row 14: K2tog

Cut yarn and pull through last stitch.

Fold each ear in half and sew together at bottom.

Sew ears securely onto the top of the bunny.

Glue a pompom to the back for a tail.

Fits over a plastic Easter egg or one of those yummy chocolate creme eggs!
