Materials:

- 2 colours of worsted weight cotton yarn
- Size 7 knitting needles

Finished size: approx. 9" wide by 9" long

Gauge:

Not critical to the project

Terms:

wyif – with yarn in front wyib – with yarn in back



This dishcloth is a real power house! It has a smooth side for washing and textured side for scrubbing. It's the best of both worlds!

Directions:

With Colour #1, cast on 44 stitches.

Change to Colour #2:

Row 1: Slip first stitch as if to purl, k1, *wyif slip 1 st as if to purl, wyib K1*, repeat from *to* to end of row.

Row 2: Knit

Repeat these 2 rows, changing colours every 2 rows, to desired length ending with colour #2. Bind off using colour #1.

Weave in ends.
